New Committee Nominations

The inaugural Annual General Meeting of the Irish Dexter Cattle Society will be convened before the end of March, 2022. The Society is now managed as a “Company Limited by Guarantee”.

A committee to carry on the business of the society will be appointed at the AGM. It is then considered that this committee will appoint the specific officers such as chairperson, secretary, treasurer, public relations officer and website coordinator, and others if considered necessary. It will also be necessary to appoint directors of the society, minimum number required is 3.

The number of people on the committee and the composition of the committee will be decided at the AGM and it is desirable that it will be a countrywide representation of members. It is also considered that the committee, or possibly some of the committee will be appointed for a three year period to provide for continuity.

Some skills such as managerial, secretarial, communication, financial, marketing & promotion, accountancy & legal skills and using information technology are desirable but not essential, so this should not deter nominations.

It is important to note that only registered members of the society will be in a position to make nominations and to vote on the selection of committee members and directors, and only registered members may be nominated. The same applies to motions to be decided at the AGM.
